## Key to Effective Service Daniel 1:8-21

### I. DANIEL'S RESOLVE (Verse 8)

- Daniel made up his mind not to defile himself with partaking of food and drink that was associated with the many pagan Babylonian gods.
- While this was considered by most within Israel as a small thing, Daniel was devoted to the interests of the Lord and chose to honour the Lord in this way.

### II. GOD'S RESULT – PART A (Verses 9-16)

- Even though Daniel's Babylonian overseer could lose his life by granting Daniel's request, God gave Daniel favor with him and he agreed to this request.
- God miraculously gave Daniel and his three friend's better health than all of the other captives who were eating the king's food.

### III. GOD'S RESULT – PART B (Verses 17-21)

- God gave Daniel and his three friends great knowledge and wisdom and Daniel was given the ability to interpret dreams and visions.
- King Nebuchadnezzar recognized this and placed all four in his personal service.
- Daniel's wisdom and knowledge greatly exceeded that of all of the Babylonian advisers to the king – a fact recognized by the king who consulted Daniel regularly.
- Daniel outlived all of the king's of the Babylonian empire revealing that his God was indeed supreme over all the Babylonian gods.
