



Bear With Each Other Galatians 6:1-5

I. RESTORE THE FALLEN (Verse 1)

- When a fellow believer becomes trapped in a sin, it is imperative that he be restored by a spiritual Christian.
- This restoration must be done with gentleness and in humility recognizing that anyone could fall.

II. RELIEVE THE LOAD (Verse 2)

- We are to support or carry or take on our self the burdens of each other (*Mat.8:17; Rom.16:1; Gal.5:13-15*).
- By doing so we are an extension of the ministry of Christ on earth (*Jn.15:12; Rom.8:2; 1 Cor.9:21*).

III. REVIEW YOUR MOTIVES (Verses 3-5)

- We need to recognize that this service to others can only be accomplished through the power of God (*Gal.6:3; Rom.7:18; Phil.4:13*).
- The primary motive for fulfilling this command is from my God given love for my brother.
- The fruit of this ministry to one another is rejoicing in the power and working of God (*Rom.5:2,3; 2 Cor.9:2; Gal.6:14; Phil.3:3*).
