## **CHRIST GREATER THAN MOSES**

*(Hebrews 3:1-6)*

### APOSTLE OF GOD (1-2)

- ***Apostle = one sent forth***
- Christ was sent by the Father into the world to be our Saviour (*John 17:3*)
- He was faithful to this appointment (*John 4:34*)

### GREATER THAN THE HOUSE (3-4)

- Moses was a faithful servant in the house of Israel (*2,5; Exodus 3:10; 40:16; Numbers 12:7*)
- Christ built and owns the house of Israel (*Isaiah 43:1; Colossians 1:16*)

### MOSES' TESTIMONY (5)

- ***Prophet = one who speaks for God***
- Moses was a great prophet to Israel, but he testified of One who would speak in an even greater way for God – Jesus Christ (*Deuteronomy 18:15,18; Hebrews 1:1-2*)

### HIS OWN HOUSE (6)

- Jesus Christ is Master over His own House – the Church (*Colossians 1:18; 1 Timothy 3:15; Hebrews 10:21*)
- We are part of that House if we put our trust and confidence in Him (*Galatians 6:10; Ephesians 2:19; 1 Peter 2:5*)



## Application

Moses was a hero to the nation of Israel 2000 years ago, and continues as one today – so much so, that he was (and is) wrongly elevated above Christ.

Who is your hero? Perhaps not Moses, but if not, then whom? There have been many “heroes” in Church history, men and women greatly used by God; however, none of these should be given a place in our hearts and minds that is above Jesus Christ.
